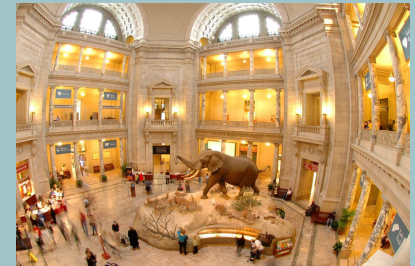

Bus Transportation

- **Students will sit with their partner and in the vicinity of their group.**

 - Chaperones need to be able to quickly see who is there and who isn't

Planning for Meals & Spending Money

- **Your student will have to pay for:**
 - Four Lunches - Average cost \$15.00 - \$18.00/lunch
 - One Dinner - Average cost \$18.00 - \$20.00/dinner
- **Plan for \$175 - \$225 per student**
- **Discuss a budget for Food and Souvenirs with your student.**
- **Discuss spending limits to make money last the entire trip.**



Chaperones

Opportunity/Availability to chaperone will depend on total number of students. Chaperones Are Chosen In this order by Administration!!!!

1. Teacher and Administration Approval
 2. Staff Participation
 3. Medical Needs
 4. Male/Female Ratio (students/chaperone)
 5. PTO Involvement
- Chaperones must stay with group at all times, have contact via cell with students and parents.
 - Chaperones are responsible for being CORI'd and fingerprinted.
 - Chaperones are responsible for a group of students from the time the bus departs Westport until its return to Westport including safety, communication, behavior, etc...
 - Chaperones **MUST** be able to walk 8-10 miles a day in very hot weather.

Fundraising

- In previous years some students have almost completely paid for their trip with the fundraisers we have offered!!!

Why a Mandatory Fundraiser?

Each year the PTO sponsors the DC Trip for our 8th Grade Students

The trip costs paid by families does not cover the entire cost of facilitating this trip. There are additional costs above and beyond what each family pays.

In an effort to keep the trip cost as affordable as possible, and not raise the per student cost, we ask that all families participate in one mandatory fundraiser.

These PTO Fundraisers help us defray the additional costs associated directly with this trip, some of which include:

- Trip Coordinator
- Wildcat Hats for all students and chaperones
- Financial Aid
- Bus Boxes with essential & extra supplies needed for each bus on the trip
- Trip overages (*ie. gas/fuel surcharges, unforeseen expenses*)

IMPORTANT FUNDRAISING NOTES

- All funds raised by students via Fundraisers **CANNOT** and **WILL NOT** be refunded to students.
- Fundraising monies raised by you if you “do not or cannot go” on the trip are non-refundable they remain with the PTO!
